KANSAS JUNE 1, 2013 GRAIN STOCKS

TOPEKA, KS, June 28, 2013 -- Kansas **wheat** stocks in all positions totaled 162.3 million bushels on June 1, 2013, according to the USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service. This was down 35 percent from March 2013, but 15 percent higher than last June. Wheat stored in off-farm facilities totaled 156.6 million bushels and accounted for 96 percent of the total. On-farm stocks totaled 5.7 million bushels, up 104 percent from last June.

Corn stocks in all positions totaled 86.6 million bushels, down 49 percent from March and 29 percent lower than last June. Off-farm stocks, at 70.6 million bushels, accounted for 82 percent of the total corn stocks. On-farm stocks, at 16.0 million bushels, were down 43 percent from the 2012 June stocks. This is the smallest June corn stocks since 2004.

Grain sorghum in all positions totaled 27.7 million bushels, down 48 percent from March 2013, and 34 percent less than a year ago. Off-farm stocks totaled 25.9 million bushels and on-farm stocks totaled 1.8 million bushels. This is the smallest June grain sorghum stocks since 1957.

Soybeans in all positions totaled 12.0 million bushels, down 65 percent from March and down 56 percent from June 2012. Off-farm stocks at 8.7 million bushels, accounted for 72 percent of the total soybean stocks. On-farm stocks at 3.3 million bushels, were down 1.0 million bushels from last June. This is the smallest June soybean stocks since 1985.

Oat stocks in off-farm facilities totaled 151,000 bushels, down 12 percent from March, but up 7 percent from June 2012.

Stocks of **barley** in off-farm facilities totaled 3,000 bushels, down from 7,000 bushels in March, and down from 8,000 bushels last June.
