KANSAS DECEMBER 1, 2013 GRAIN AND HAY STOCKS

TOPEKA, KS, January 10, 2014 -- Kansas **corn** stocks in all positions on December 1, 2013 totaled 316 million bushels, up 29 percent from 2012, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 100 million bushels are stored on farms, up 47 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 216 million bushels, are up 21 percent from last year.

Wheat stored in all positions totaled 253 million bushels, down 21 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 11.5 million bushels are down 28 percent from 2012 and off-farm stocks of 241 million bushels are down 21 percent from last year.

Sorghum stored in all positions totaled 138 million bushels, nearly double the holdings of 2012. On-farm stocks of 14 million are up 56 percent and off farm holdings of 124 million are up 96 percent from last year

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 91.4 million bushels, up 37 percent from last year. On-farm stocks of 27.5 million bushels are up 72 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 63.9 million bushels, are up 26 percent from 2012.

Hay stocks on Kansas farms totaled 4.5 million tons on December 1, 2013, up 50 percent from a year earlier.

Grain storage capacity in Kansas totaled 1.38 billion bushels, up 20 million bushels from December 1, 2012. Total grain storage capacity is comprised of 380 million bushels of on-farm storage, unchanged from last year, and 1.0 billion bushels of off-farm storage, up 20 million bushels from 2012.
