KANSAS MARCH 1, 2014 GRAIN STOCKS

TOPEKA, KS, March 31, 2014 -- Kansas **corn** stocks in all positions on March 31, 2014 totaled 221 million bushels, up 31 percent from 2013, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 68.0 million bushels are stored on farms, double a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 153 million bushels, are up 14 percent from last year.

Wheat stored in all positions totaled 183 million bushels, down 27 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 5.40 million bushels are down 43 percent from 2013 and off-farm stocks of 178 million bushels are down 26 percent from last year.

Sorghum stored in all positions totaled 103 million bushels, nearly double the holdings of 2013. On-farm stocks of 7.50 million are up 15 percent and off-farm holdings of 95.4 million are up 104 percent from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 39.9 million bushels, up 16 percent from last year. On-farm stocks of 9.20 million bushels are down 5 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 30.7 million bushels, are up 25 percent from 2013.
