## KANSAS 2014 SMALL GRAIN ACREAGE AND PRODUCTION

TOPEKA, KS, September 30, 2014 – **Winter wheat** production is estimated at 246 million bushels, down 23 percent from last year and lowest since 1989, according to USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Planted acreage totaled 9.60 million acres, up 1 percent from a year earlier. Acres harvested for grain totaled 8.80 million acres, up 4 percent from 2013. Yield at 28 bushels per acre, is down 10 bushels from 2013.

**Oat** production is estimated at 840,000 bushels, unchanged from 2013. Planted acreage totaled 85,000, down 15 percent from a year earlier. Area harvested for grain, at 15,000 acres, is down 25 percent from last year and a record low. Yield of 56 bushels per acre, is up 14 bushels from 2013.

**Barley** production is estimated at 350,000 bushels, down 32 percent from 2013. Planted acreage totaled 16,000, down 1,000 acres from a year earlier. Area harvested for grain, at 10,000 acres, is also down 1,000 acres from last year. Yield, at 35 bushels per acre, is down 12 bushels from 2013.
