KANSAS SEPTEMBER 1, 2015 GRAIN STOCKS

TOPEKA, KS, September 30, 2015 -- Kansas old crop **corn** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2015 totaled 68.7 million bushels, up 75 percent from 2014, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, on farm holdings of 13.5 million bushels are near triple the holdings of a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 55.2 million bushels, are up 60 percent from last year.

Old crop soybeans stored in all positions totaled 8.98 million bushels, near four times last year. On-farm stocks of 1.55 million bushels rebounded nearly seven times off the forty-four year low of a last year. Off-farm stocks, at 7.43 million bushels, are more than three times the holdings in 2014.

Old crop sorghum stored in all positions totaled 9.10 million bushels, down 57 percent from 2014. On-farm stocks of 990,000 are down 24 percent and off farm holdings of 8.11 million are down 59 percent from last year.

Wheat stored in all positions totaled 378 million bushels, up 37 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 23.0 million are up 24 percent from 2014 and off-farm stocks of 355 million bushels are up 38 percent from last year.

Off-farm holdings of **oats** totaled 858,000 bushels, up 59 percent from 2014.
