2015 KANSAS SMALL GRAIN ACREAGE AND PRODUCTION

TOPEKA, KS, September 30, 2015 - **Winter wheat** production is estimated at 322 million bushels, up 31 percent from last year. The area harvested for grain totaled 8.7 million acres, down 1 percent from 2014. Planted acreage totaled 9.2 million, down 4 percent from a year earlier. The yield is 37.0 bushels per acre, up 9.0 bushels from last year.

Oat production is estimated at 2.6 million bushels, more than three times that of 2014. Area harvested for grain, at 40,000 acres, is up 167 percent from last year. Planted acreage totaled 95,000, up 12 percent from a year earlier. Average yield is a record 65.0 bushels per acre, up 9.0 bushels from 2014.

Barley production is estimated at 312,000 bushels, down 11 percent from 2014. Area harvested for grain, at 8,000 acres, is down 20 percent from last year. Planted acreage totaled 13,000, down 19 percent from a year earlier. Average yield is 39.0 bushels per acre, up 4.0 bushels from last year.
