KANSAS CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

Manhattan, KS – Based on June 1 conditions, Kansas’s 2016 **winter wheat** crop is forecast at 394 million bushels, up 22 percent from last year’s crop, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. Average yield is forecast at 48 bushels per acre, up 11 bushels from last year.

Acreage to be harvested for grain is estimated at 8.20 million acres, down 500,000 acres from last year. This would be 96 percent of the planted acres, above last year’s 95 percent harvested.
