## KANSAS DECEMBER 1, 2015 GRAIN AND HAY STOCKS

TOPEKA, KS, January 12, 2016 -- Kansas **corn** stocks in all positions on December 1, 2015 totaled 396 million bushels, up 4 percent from 2014, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 130 million bushels are stored on farms, unchanged from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 266 million bushels, are up 6 percent from last year.

**Wheat** stored in all positions totaled 321 million bushels, up 34 percent from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 17 million bushels are up 26 percent from 2014 and off-farm stocks of 304 million bushels are up 35 percent from last year.

**Sorghum** stored in all positions totaled 215 million bushels, up 38 percent from last year. On-farm stocks of 32.0 million are up 88 percent and off farm holdings of 183 million are up 32 percent from last year

**Soybeans** stored in all positions totaled 106 million bushels, up 1 percent from last year. On-farm stocks of 25.0 million bushels are up 4 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 81.3 million bushels, are down slightly from 2014.

**Hay stocks** on Kansas farms totaled 5.1 million tons on December 1, 2015, up 38 percent from a year earlier.

**Grain storage capacity** in Kansas totaled 1.43 billion bushels, up 25.0 million bushels from December 1, 2014. Total grain storage capacity is comprised of 380 million bushels of on-farm storage, unchanged from last year, and 1.05 billion bushels of off-farm storage, up 25.0 million bushels from 2014.
