KANSAS CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

MANHATTAN, Kan. May 12, 2022 - Based on May 1 conditions, Kansas's 2022 **winter wheat** crop is forecast at 271 million bushels, down 26% from last year's crop, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Average yield is forecast at 39 bushels per acre, down 13 bushels from last year. Acreage to be harvested for grain is estimated at 6.95 million acres, down 50,000 acres from last year. This would be 94% of the planted acres, below last year's 96% harvested.

May 1 hay stocks of 670,000 tons are down 26% from last year.
