KANSAS DECEMBER 1, 2020 GRAIN AND HAY STOCKS

MANHATTAN, Kan. January 12, 2021- Kansas **corn** stocks in all positions on December 1, 2020 totaled 499 million bushels, down 8% from 2019, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 170 million bushels are stored on farms, down 13% from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 329 million bushels, are down 5% from last year.

Wheat stored in all positions totaled 288 million bushels, down 27% from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 10.0 million bushels are down 56% from 2019, and off-farm stocks of 278 million bushels are down 25% from last year.

Sorghum stored in all positions totaled 162 million bushels, down 6% from last year. On-farm stocks of 14.0 million bushels are down 30% and off farm holdings of 148 million bushels are down 3% from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 141 million bushels, down 20% from last year. On-farm stocks of 37.0 million bushels are down 20% from a year ago, and off-farm stocks, at 104 million bushels, are down 21% from 2019.

Oats off-farm stocks totaled 730,000 bushels, up 165% from 2019.

Hay stocks on Kansas farms totaled 5.00 million tons on December 1, 2020, down 6% from a year earlier.

Grain storage capacity in Kansas totaled 1.58 billion bushels, up 25.0 million bushels from December 1, 2019. Total grain storage capacity is comprised of 380 million bushels of on-farm storage, unchanged from last year, and 1.20 billion bushels of off-farm storage, up 25.0 million bushels from 2019.
