2018 KANSAS SMALL GRAIN ACREAGE AND PRODUCTION

MANHATTAN, Kan. September 28, 2018 - Winter wheat production is estimated at 277 million bushels, down 17 percent from last year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The area harvested for grain totaled 7.30 million acres, up 5 percent from 2017. Planted acreage totaled 7.70 million acres, up 1 percent from a year earlier. The yield is 38.0 bushels per acre, down 10 bushels from 2017.

Oat production is estimated at 882,000 bushels, down 35 percent from 2017. Area harvested for grain, at 18,000 acres, is down 28 percent from last year. Planted acreage totaled 120,000 acres, up 20 percent from a year earlier. Yield is 49.0 bushels per acre, down 5 bushels per acre from last year.

Barley production is estimated at 186,000 bushels. Area harvested for grain is 6,000 acres. Planted acreage totaled 17,000 acres. Average yield is 31.0 bushels per acre.
