KANSAS 2020 FARM REAL ESTATE VALUE AND CASH RENT

MANHATTAN, Kan. August 6, 2020 - Kansas's **farm real estate value**, a measurement of the value of all land and buildings on farms, decreased from 2019, according to USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Farm real estate value for 2020 averaged \$1,900 per acre, down \$60 per acre (down 3%) from last year.

Cropland value decreased 4% from last year to \$2,080 per acre. **Dryland cropland value** averaged \$1,970 per acre, \$80 lower than last year. **Irrigated cropland value** averaged \$3,270 per acre, \$50 below a year ago. **Pastureland**, at \$1,370 per acre, was \$20 lower than the previous year.

Cash rents paid to landlords in 2020 for cropland were mixed from last year. **Irrigated cropland rent** averaged \$129 per acre, \$1 above last year. **Dryland cropland rent** averaged \$56 per acre, \$1 lower than a year earlier. **Pasture** rented for cash averaged \$19.50 per acre, \$0.50 above the previous year.
