KANSAS COMPUTER AND INTERNET USE ON FARMS

TOPEKA, KS, August 19, 2015 -- According to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, 72 percent of Kansas farms had access to computers in 2015. This compares to the national average of 73 percent. Seventy-one percent of farms in Kansas had internet access, up 3 percentage points from the last time this data was collected in 2013.
