## KANSAS COMPUTER AND INTERNET USE ON FARMS

**MANHATTAN, Kan. August 18, 2017** - According to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, 72 percent of Kansas farms had access to computers in 2017. This compares to the national average of 73 percent. 71 percent of farms in Kansas had internet access, unchanged from the last time this data was collected in 2015.
