Kansas Farm Production Expenditures up 20.9 Percent in 2007

Kansas Farm Expenditures totaled \$12.40 billion in 2007, up 20.9 percent from the revised 2006 total of \$10.26 billion. Total farm expenditures at the U.S. level climbed 9.3 percent to \$260 billion. Kansas operations accounted for 4.8 percent of the National farm expenditures.

The top four expense categories with the largest per farm percent increase in Kansas were: Tractors and Self Propelled Machinery up 35 percent, Trucks and Autos up 31 percent, Feed up 29 percent and Fertilizer, Lime and Soil Conditioners up 28 percent.

Data for this publication are a result of the Agricultural Resource Management Survey Phase III (ARMS III). Nationally, 31,924 farm operations were contacted during the months of January to April 2008 with 18,709 operations responding.



Average per Farm Expenditures Rise to \$194,357

An average of \$194,357 was spent on farm expenses in Kansas for the 2007 year. This is up 21 percent from the 2006 average of \$160,313. Since Kansas expenditure estimates began being published in 2004, average expenditures have risen 48 percent.

On average, the top five expenditures on a Kansas operation were: Livestock at \$61,599, Feed at \$30,408, Farm services at \$16,458, Rent at \$12,539, and Fertilizer at \$11,442.
