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KANSAS RANKED 7th IN VALUE OF AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS

Kansas ranked seventh among the 50 states as an exporter of agricultural products during fiscal year (FY) 2010, down one place from 2009, according to data compiled by the USDA's Economic Research Service. The value of exports from all of the top ten states increased from 2009. The total value of Kansas exports, at \$4.87 billion, is up 3 percent from the previous fiscal year but still is the second highest since our records began in 1973. Exports increased from 2009 for Soybeans & Products, Feeds & Fodders, Hides & Skins, and Animal Fats while declining for all other categories. Kansas accounted for 4.5 percent of the \$108.7 billion of U.S. agricultural exports in FY 2010.

Kansas ranked first in the Nation for Wheat & Products and Feed & Fodders. The export numbers show Kansas ranking second in Hides & Skins and Animal Fats, and third in Sunflower Seed & Oil. Other top ten rankings for Kansas were Live Animals & Meat (fourth with \$675 million), Feed Grains & Products (fifth with \$855 million), Seeds (fifth with \$44 million), and Soybeans & Products (tenth with \$916 million). Wheat & Products accounted for 23 percent of the State total and 13 percent of the National All Wheat & Products exports. Soybeans & Products comprised 19 percent of the Kansas exports and 4 percent of all U.S. Soybeans & Products exports. Feed Grains & Products tallied 18 and 7 percent of the State and National exports, respectively.

U.S. AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS UP 13 PERCENT

The United States exported \$108.7 billion of agricultural commodities in FY 2010, up 13 percent from 2009. California continued to lead the Nation in agricultural exports at \$12.8 billion. Iowa ranked second, followed by, Texas, Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Kansas, Indiana, North Dakota, and Missouri. Agricultural export estimates by State are based on the assumption that if a State contributes a certain percentage of U.S. production, it contributes a similar percentage of export revenues. When appropriate, however, supplemental data (Customs district data, domestic use data, and the Census of Agriculture data, for example) were used to adjust the export share.
