KANSAS FARM NUMBERS LOWER

TOPEKA, KS, February 18, 2016 – Kansas's number of farms and ranches declined during 2015, according to USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The number of farms and ranches in the State, at 60,400, was down 600 farms from 2014. Numbers of farms and ranches in Kansas with less than \$100,000 in agricultural sales decreased 800 farms from the year earlier while operations with more than \$100,000 in agricultural sales increased 200 farms.

Land in farms and ranches in Kansas totaled 46 million acres, unchanged from 2014. The average size of operation, at 762 acres, was up 8 acres from the year earlier.
