## KANSAS AGRICULTURAL PRICES

TOPEKA, KS, July 31, 2014 – The preliminary July price received by farmers for winter wheat averaged \$6.31 per bushel, a decrease of 53 cents from the June price according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

The preliminary July corn price, at \$3.92 per bushel, is down 64 cents from last month.

The preliminary July sorghum price averaged \$6.42 per cwt, a decrease of \$1.17 from June.

The preliminary July soybean price, at \$12.50 per bushel, is down \$1.90 from last month.

The July alfalfa hay price, at \$184 per ton, is down \$28 from June. The other hay price, at \$103 per ton, is up \$2 from last month.

The preliminary July sunflower price is withheld to avoid disclosing data for individual operations.
