## **KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 2 PERCENT**

TOPEKA, KS, June, 20, 2014 -- Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.02 million cattle on feed on June 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was down 2 percent from last year. This is the lowest June inventory since 1999.

Placements during May totaled 435,000 head, up 1 percent from 2013.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of May totaled 400,000 head, down 2 percent from last year.

Other disappearance during May totaled 25,000 head, up 5,000 head from last year.
