KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED UP 1 PERCENT

TOPEKA, KS, November 21, 2014 -- Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.08 million cattle on feed on November 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up 1 percent from last year.

Placements during October totaled 420,000 head, down 11 percent from 2013.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of October totaled 320,000 head, down 20 percent from last year.

Other disappearance during October totaled 30,000 head, up 10,000 from last year.
