## **KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED UP 2 PERCENT**

TOPEKA, KS, December 19, 2014 -- Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.10 million cattle on feed on December 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up 2 percent from last year.

Placements during November totaled 320,000 head, down 12 percent from 2013. This is the lowest November placements since the series began in 1994.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of November totaled 285,000 head, down 17 percent from last year. This is the lowest November marketings since the series began in 1994.

Other disappearance during November totaled 15,000 head, down 5,000 from last year.
