KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED UP SLIGHTLY FROM LAST YEAR

TOPEKA, KS, October 23, 2015 -- Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.02 million cattle on feed on October 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up slightly from last year.

Placements during September totaled 400,000 head, unchanged from 2014.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of September totaled 320,000 head, down 2 percent from last year.

Other disappearance during September totaled 10,000 head, down 5,000 head from last year.
