## **KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED UP 4 PERCENT**

TOPEKA, KS, March 18, 2016 -- Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.16 million cattle on feed on March 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up 4 percent from last year.

Placements during February totaled 375,000 head, up 6 percent from 2015.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of February totaled 345,000 head, down 3 percent from last year.

Other disappearance during February totaled 10,000 head, unchanged head from last year.
