KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED UP 9 PERCENT

Manhattan, KS – Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.11 million cattle on feed on August 1, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up 9 percent from last year.

Placements during July totaled 445,000 head, up 13 percent from 2015.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of July totaled 375,000 head, down 5 percent from last year.

Other disappearance during July totaled 10,000 head, unchanged from last year.
