## **KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION**

TOPEKA, KS, June 18, 2014 -- Milk production in Kansas during May 2014 totaled 276 million pounds, up seven percent from May 2013, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 141,000 head. Milk production per cow averaged 1,955 pounds.
