## KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION

TOPEKA, KS, October 20, 2014 -- Milk production in Kansas during September 2014 totaled 250 million pounds, up nine percent from September 2013, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 143,000 head, 9,000 head more than September 2013. Milk production per cow averaged 1,750 pounds.
