KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION

TOPEKA, KS, March 19, 2015 -- Milk production in Kansas during February 2015 totaled 247 million pounds, up 6 percent from February 2014, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 143,000 head, 6,000 head more than February 2014. Milk production per cow averaged 1,730 pounds.
