KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION

TOPEKA, KS, October 20, 2015 -- Milk production in Kansas during September 2015 totaled 257 million pounds, up 2 percent from September 2014, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 144,000 head, 1,000 head more than September 2014. Milk production per cow averaged 1,785 pounds.
