KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION

TOPEKA, KS, November 19, 2015 -- Milk production in Kansas during October 2015 totaled 264 million pounds, down less than 1 percent from October 2014, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 143,000 head, unchanged from October 2014. Milk production per cow averaged 1,845 pounds.
