## **KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION**

TOPEKA, KS, February 19, 2016 -- Milk production in Kansas during January 2016 totaled 270 million pounds, unchanged from January 2015, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 142,000 head, 1,000 head less than January 2015. Milk production per cow averaged 1,900 pounds.
