## Kansas Milk Production

**Manhattan, KS** – Milk production in Kansas during April 2016 totaled 279 million pounds, down less than 1 percent from April 2015, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 144,000 head, unchanged from April 2015. Milk production per cow averaged 1,940 pounds.
