Kansas Milk Production

Manhattan, KS – Milk production in Kansas during June 2016 totaled 268 million pounds, up 3 percent from June 2015, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 145,000 head, 2,000 head more than June 2015. Milk production per cow averaged 1,845 pounds.
