KANSAS JANUARY 1 CATTLE INVENTORY

MANHATTAN, Kan. January 31, 2018 - All cattle and calves in Kansas as of January 1, 2018 totaled 6.30 million head, down 2 percent from January 1, 2017, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

All cows and heifers that had calved totaled 1.66 million head, down 3 percent from last year.

Beef cows totaled 1.51 million head, down 4 percent from last year.

Milk cows totaled 153,000 head, up 2 percent from January 1, 2017.

All heifers 500 pounds and over totaled 1.91 million head, up 4 percent from last year.

Steers weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 2.02 million head, down 1 percent from last year.

Bulls weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 95,000 head, unchanged from last year.

Calves under 500 pounds totaled 615,000 head, down 12 percent from January 1, 2017.

All cattle on feed fed for slaughter in Kansas feedlots totaled 2.45 million head, up 7 percent from the previous year.

The **2017 calf crop** totaled 1.43 million head, down 3 percent from 2016.
