## KANSAS JANUARY 1 CATTLE INVENTORY

**MANHATTAN, Kan. February 28, 2019** - All cattle and calves in Kansas as of January 1, 2019 totaled 6.35 million head, up 1 percent from January 1, 2018, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

**All cows and heifers** that had calved totaled 1.69 million head, up 2 percent from last year.

**Beef cows** totaled 1.53 million head, up 2 percent from last year.

**Milk cows** totaled 161,000 head, up 3 percent from January 1, 2018.

**All heifers** 500 pounds and over totaled 1.87 million head, down 2 percent from last year.

**Steers** weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 2.01 million head, down slightly from last year.

**Bulls** weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 95,000 head, unchanged from last year.

**Calves** under 500 pounds totaled 685,000 head, up 11 percent from January 1, 2018.

**All cattle on feed** fed for slaughter in Kansas feedlots totaled 2.43 million head, down 1 percent from the previous year.

The **2018 calf crop** totaled 1.50 million head, up 5 percent from 2017.
