KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION

MANHATTAN, Kan. December 17, 2020 - Milk production in Kansas during November 2020 totaled 336 million pounds, up 6% from November 2019, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 173,000 head, 8,000 head more than November 2019. Milk production per cow averaged 1,940 pounds.
