## KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION

**MANHATTAN, Kan. June 21, 2022** - Milk production in Kansas during May 2022 totaled 356 million pounds, down slightly from May 2021, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 172,000 head, 3,000 head less than May 2021. Milk production per cow averaged 2,070 pounds.
