KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION

MANHATTAN, Kan. October 20, 2022 - Milk production in Kansas during September 2022 totaled 340 million pounds, up 4% from September 2021, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 175,000 head, 5,000 head more than September 2021. Milk production per cow averaged 1,945 pounds.
