According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Louisiana, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, June 5, 2022**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 19 percent very short, 20 percent short, 58 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 36 percent short, 60 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus.
