According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Louisiana, there were 3.9 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, August 21, 2022**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 10 percent short, 62 percent adequate, and 25 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 9 percent very short, 17 percent short, 57 percent adequate, and 17 percent surplus.
