Corn Yield and Production Up from 2022 Cotton Yield and Production Down from 2022 Rice Yield and Production Up from 2022 Soybean Yield and Production Down from 2022 Sugarcane Yield and Production Down from 2022

Louisiana **corn** area harvested is 680,000, up 56 percent from 2022. The average yield is estimated at 175 bushels per acre, up 5 bushels from last year. Production totaled 119 million bushels, up 61 percent from 2022.

Upland cotton harvested acres is 115,000, down 39 percent from 2022. The yield is expected to average 877 pounds per harvested acre, down 27 pounds from last year. Production is estimated at 210,000 bales, down 41 percent from 2022.

All hay harvested is 390,000 acres, up 3 percent from 2022. The average yield is estimated at 2.10 tons per acre, down 0.30 ton from last year. Production totaled 819,000 tons, down 10 percent from 2022.

All rice acres harvested is 462,000 acres, up 12 percent from 2022. The all rice yield is estimated at 6,800 pounds per acre, up 140 pounds from last year. Production totaled 31.4 million hundredweight, up 14 percent from 2022.

Soybean area harvested is 980 thousand acres, down 19 percent from 2022. The average yield is estimated at 40 bushels per acre, down 7 bushels from last year. Production totaled 39.2 million bushels, down 31 percent from 2022.

Area harvested for **sugarcane** (sugar and seed) is 508,600 acres, up 2 percent from 2022. The average yield is estimated at 28.7 net tons per acre, down 3.6 net tons from last year. Production totaled 14.6 million net tons, down 9 percent from 2022.








