### Pecan Utilized Production Up in Arkansas and Louisiana while Down in Mississippi

**Arkansas:** Pecan utilized production is 3.5 million pounds, up 29 percent from the 2013 production of 2.7 million pounds. The average price per pound was \$1.32 per pound, a \$0.08 decrease from 2013. The total value of the crop was \$4.61 million, up from 2013's \$3.78 million.

**Louisiana:** Pecan utilized production is 14 million pounds, up 27 percent from the 2013 production of 11 million pounds. The average price per pound was \$0.914 per pound, a \$0.02 decrease from 2013. The total value of the crop was \$12.8 million, up from 2013's \$10.3 million.

**Mississippi:** Pecan utilized production is 1 million pounds, down 82 percent from the 2013 production of 5.5 million pounds. The average price per pound was \$1.42 per pound, a \$0.28 increase from 2013. The total value of the crop was \$1.42 million, down from 2013's \$6.29 million.

**United States:** Pecan utilized production is 265 million pounds, down slightly from last year's crop. The average price per pound was \$1.91 per pound, a \$0.18 increase from 2013. The total value of the crop was \$508 million, up from 2013's \$460 million.
