Louisiana Hog Inventory Unchanged

Louisiana inventory of all hogs and pigs on December 1, 2018, totaled 6,000 head, unchanged from December 1, 2017. Breeding hog inventory, at 2,000 head, unchanged from the previous year, and market hog inventory, at 4,000 head, unchanged the previous year. For the December 2017 – November 2018 period, the pig crop totaled 5,600 head, unchanged from the same time period the previous year. Sows farrowing during the period totaled 800 head, unchanged from the previous year. The average number of pigs saved per litter for December 2017 – November 2018 was 7.00 head, unchanged from last year.
