Broiler-Type Eggs Set Down 11 Percent from Last Year

Louisiana hatcheries set 3.32 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending August 1, 2020, down 11 percent from the comparable week in 2019 and down 1 percent from the previous week.


Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 230 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 1, 2020, down 2 percent from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Down 9 Percent


Louisiana broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 2.92 million chicks during the week ending August 1, 2020, down 9 percent from the comparable week in 2019 but up slightly from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 187 million chicks for meat production during the week ending August 1, 2020, down slightly from a year ago.
