Milk Production Down 7 Percent from Previous Quarter

Louisiana **milk production** during the April - June 2019 quarter was 37.0 million pounds, down 14 percent from the same period in 2018 and down 7 percent from the January - March quarter. The average number of milk cows on farms during the quarter was 10,500 head, 1,000 head lower than the same period last year and 500 head lower than the previous quarter.

Milk Production in the United States during the April - June quarter totaled 55.8 billion pounds, down 0.1 percent from the April - June quarter last year. The average number of milk cows in the United States during the quarter was 9.33 million head, 15,000 head lower than the January - March quarter, and 89,000 head lower than the same period last year.
