Milk Production Up 14 Percent from Previous Quarter

Louisiana **milk production** during the October - December 2022 quarter was 25.0 million pounds, down 11 percent from the same period in 2021 but up 14 percent from the July - September quarter. The average number of milk cows on farms during the quarter was 8,000 head, 1,000 head lower than the same period last year but unchanged from the previous quarter.

Milk Production in the United States during the October - December quarter totaled 56.0 billion pounds, up 1 percent from the October - December quarter last year. The average number of milk cows in the United States during the quarter was 9.41 million head, 4,000 head lower than the July - September quarter, but 27,000 head higher than the same period last year.


