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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 5.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday; April 5th, 2020. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 88 percent adequate, and 11 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 1 percent short, 89 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. In **Delaware**, there were 4.0 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 42 percent adequate, and 58 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 32 percent adequate, and 68 percent surplus.
