Maryland Grain Stocks

ANNAPOLIS, MD – Maryland **corn** stored off farms on September 1, 2015 was 2.7 million bushels, up from last year's level of 1.1 million bushels, according to Dale Hawks, State Statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, Maryland Field Office.

Wheat stored off farms totaled 13.8 million bushels, down from last year's total of 16.1 million bushels. **Barley** stored off farms totaled 233 thousand bushels, down significantly from last year's total of 1.6 million bushels.
