Weekly Broiler Chicks Data

PLACEMENTS UP 4%

For the week ending January 17, 2015, growers placed 11.7 million broiler chicks in Delmarva growing houses, according to the Maryland Field Office of USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. These placements were 4.5% above the comparable week a year earlier. Eggs set in incubators during the week totaled 13.8 million, an increase of 3.6% from the same week a year earlier. Federally inspected slaughter on Delmarva was 12.0 million for the week ending January 10, 2015 compared to 11.3 million slaughtered during the same week in 2014.



Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 214 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 17, 2015, up 3 percent from a year ago. Hatcheries in the 19 State weekly program set 206 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 17, 2015, up 3 percent from the year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 83 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 175 million chicks for meat production during the week ending January 17, 2015, up 2 percent from a year ago. Broiler growers in the 19 State weekly program placed 169 million chicks for meat production during the week ending January 17, 2015, up 2 percent from the year earlier. Cumulative placements from January 10, 2015 through January 17, 2015 for the United States were 351 million. Cumulative placements were up 3 percent from the same period a year earlier.
