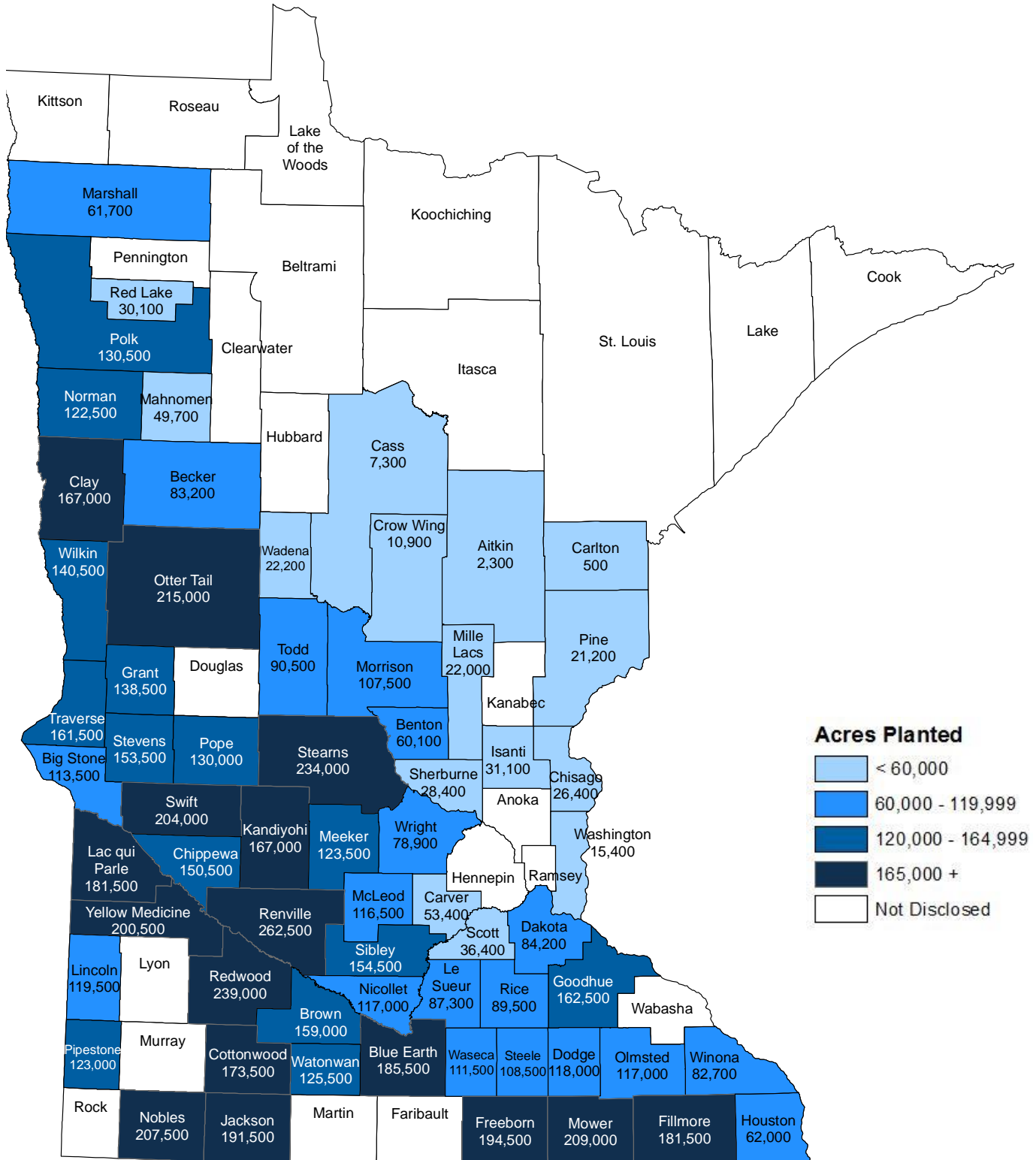


# Corn Planted for All Purposes – Minnesota: 2023

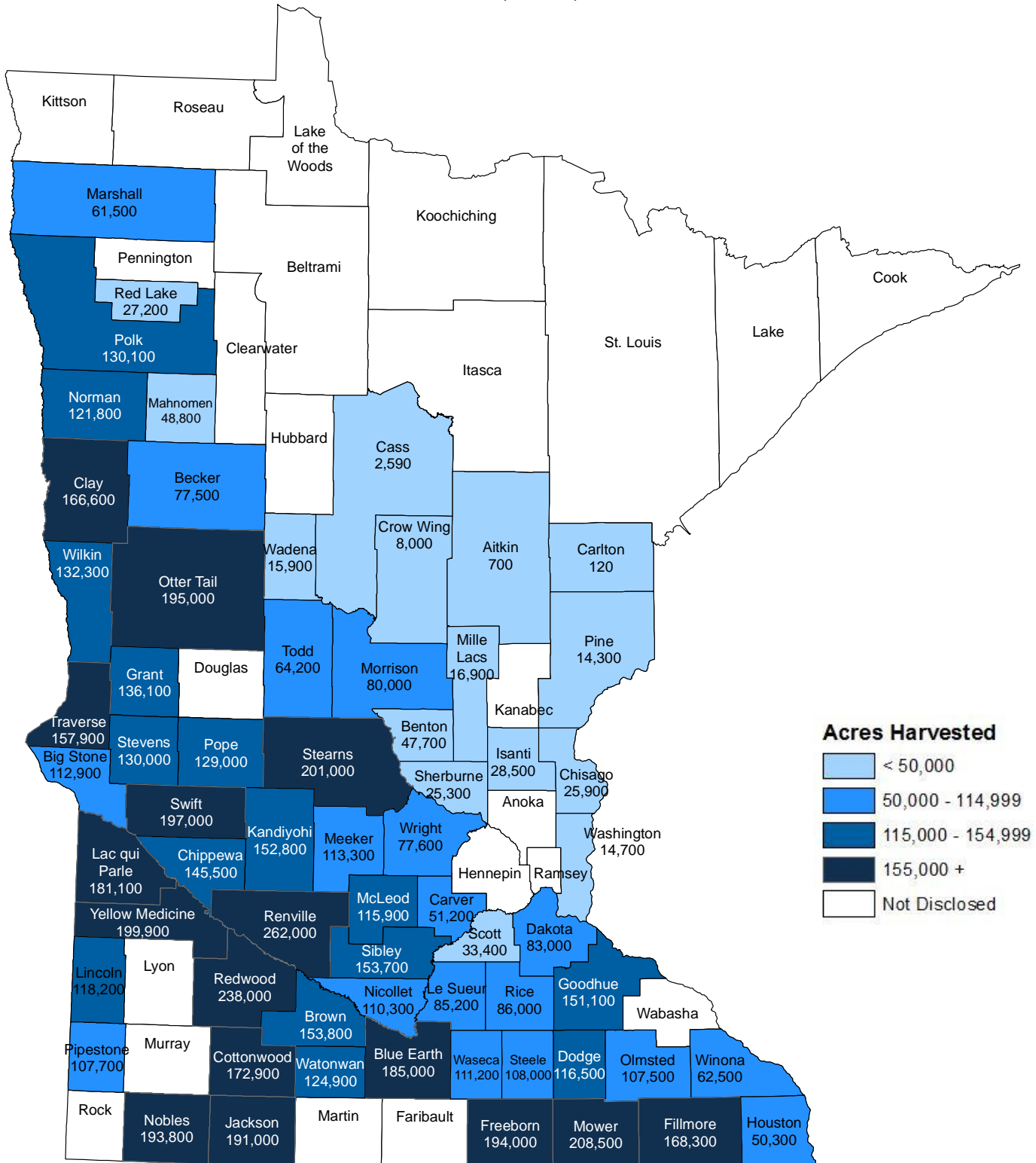

State Total: 8,180,000 Acres



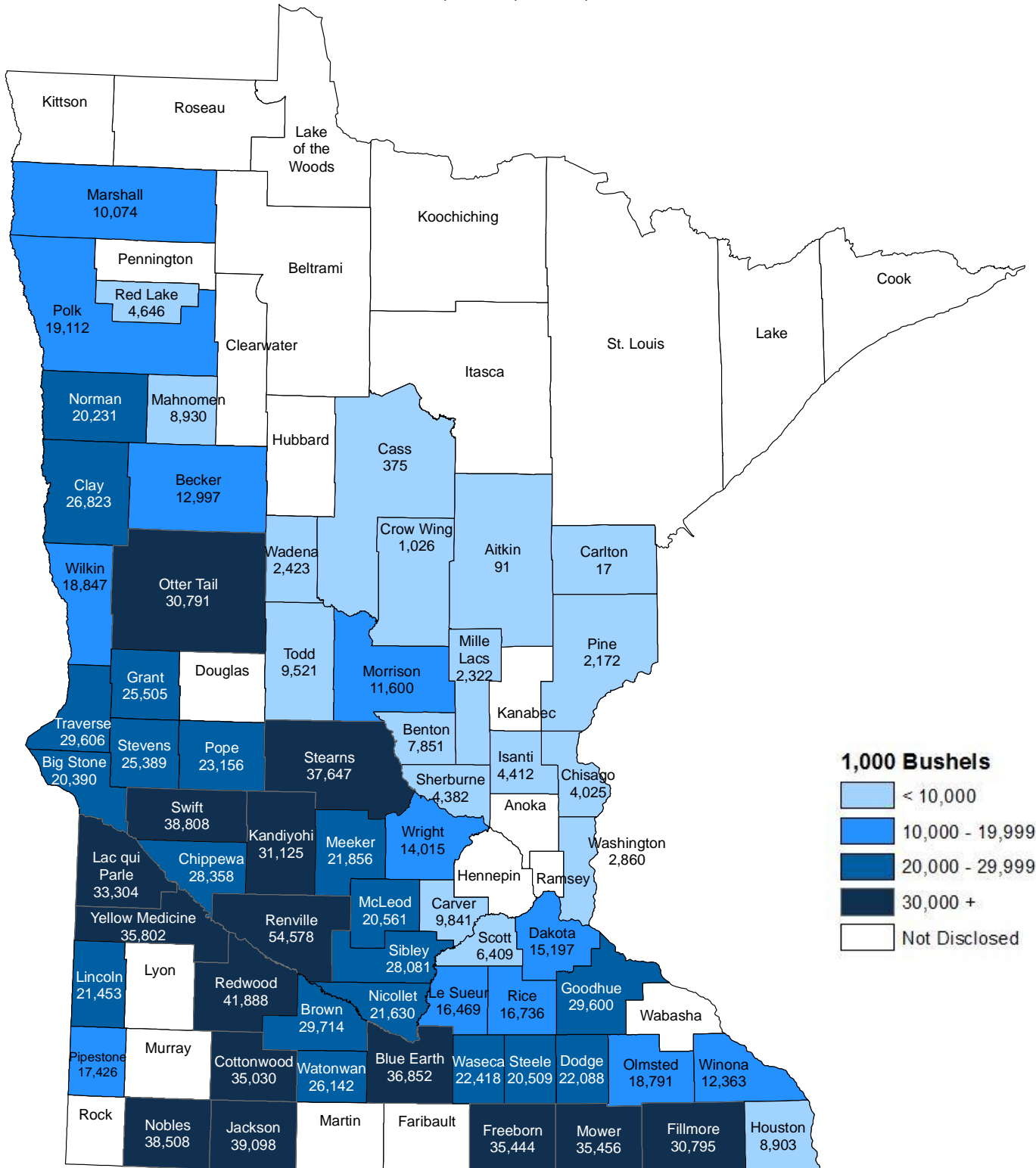

State Total: 1,513,300,000 Bushels



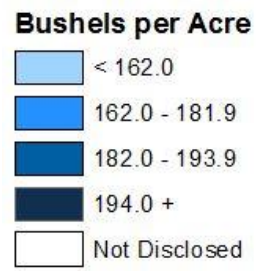
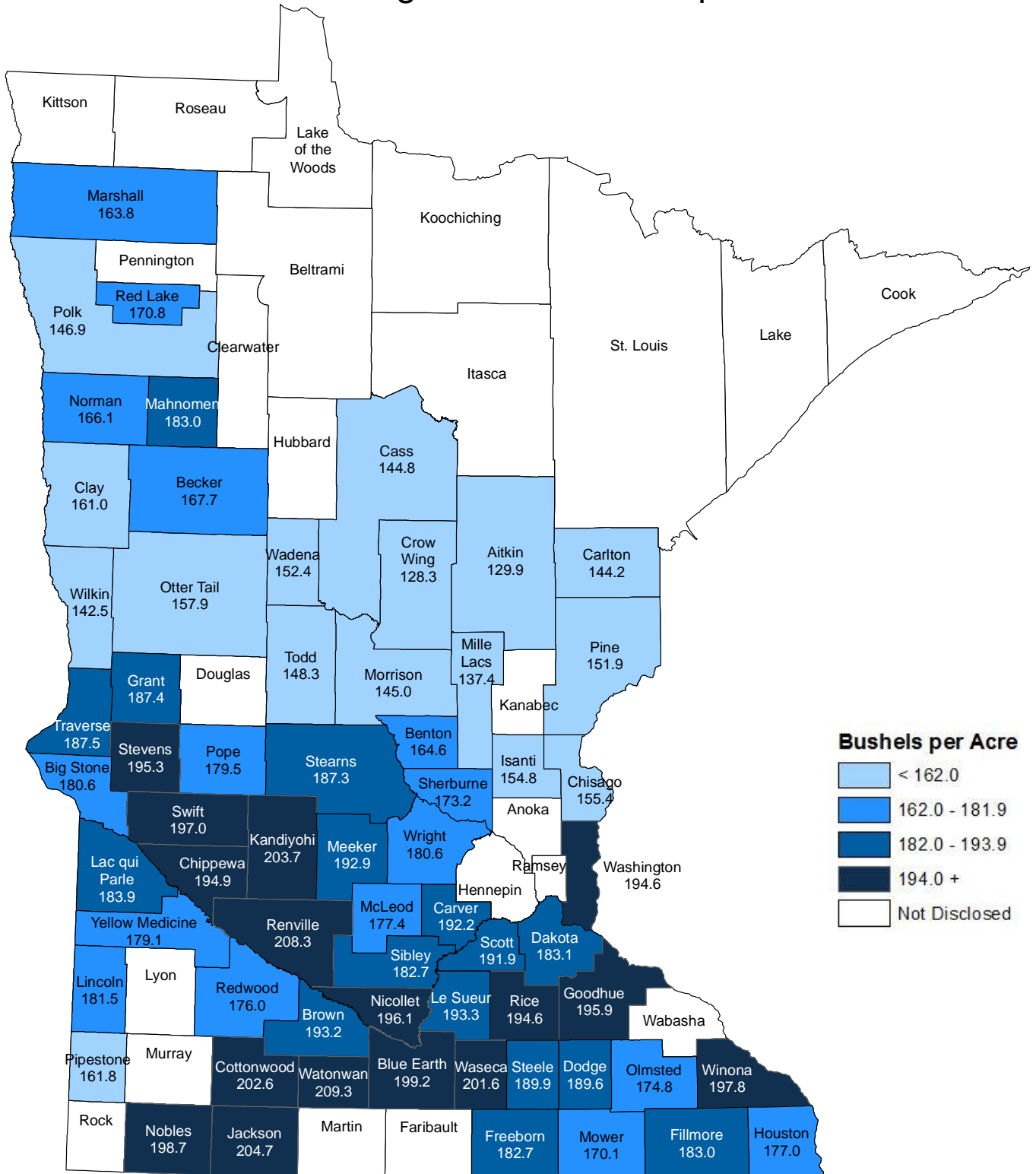

State Average: 185.0 Bushels per Acre



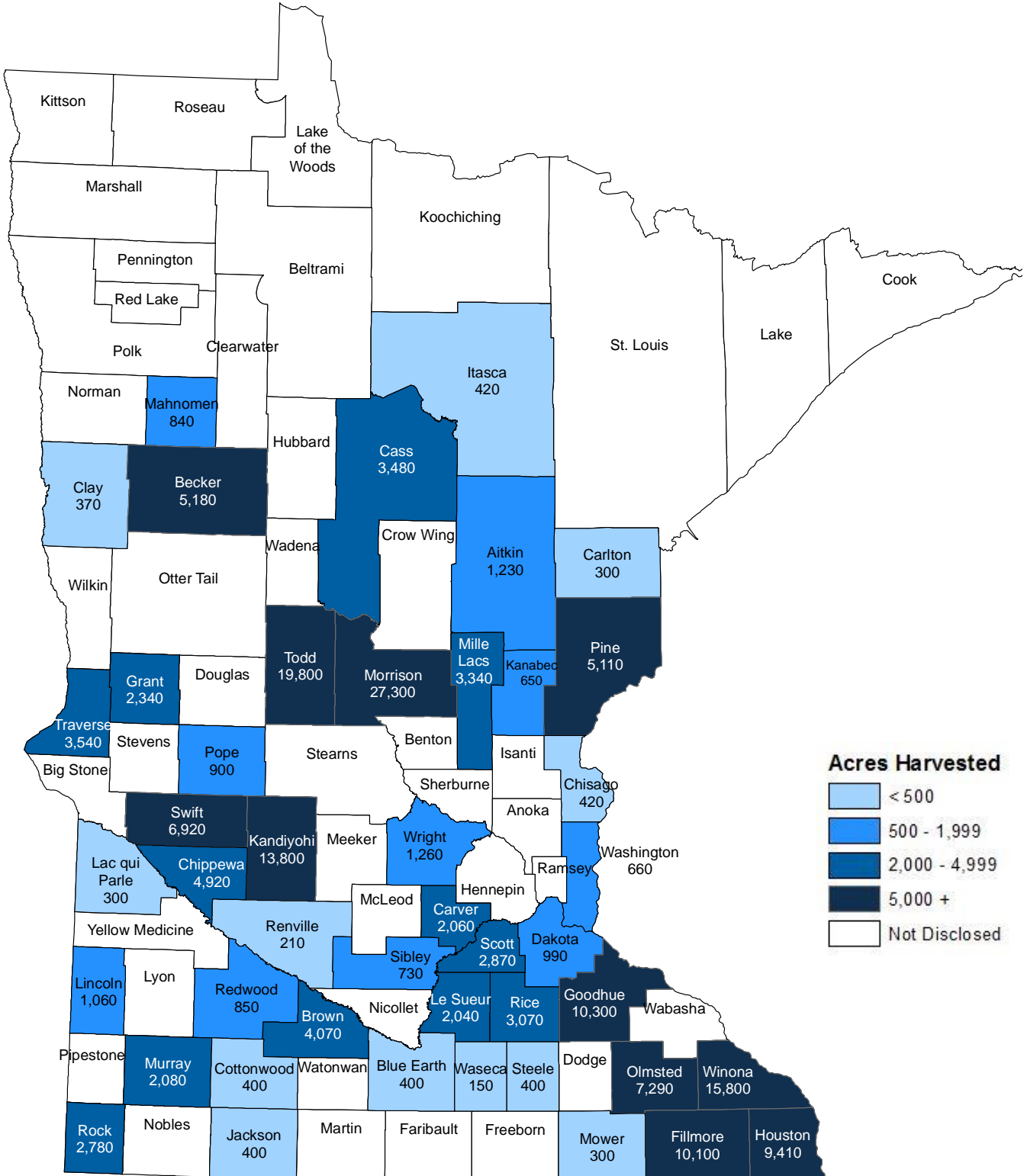

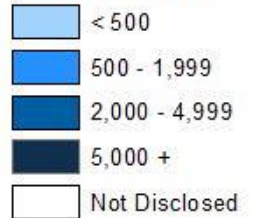


# Corn Harvested for Silage – Minnesota: 2023

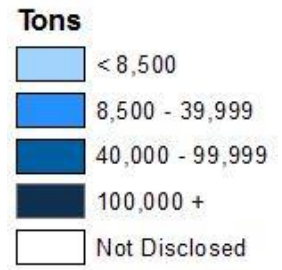
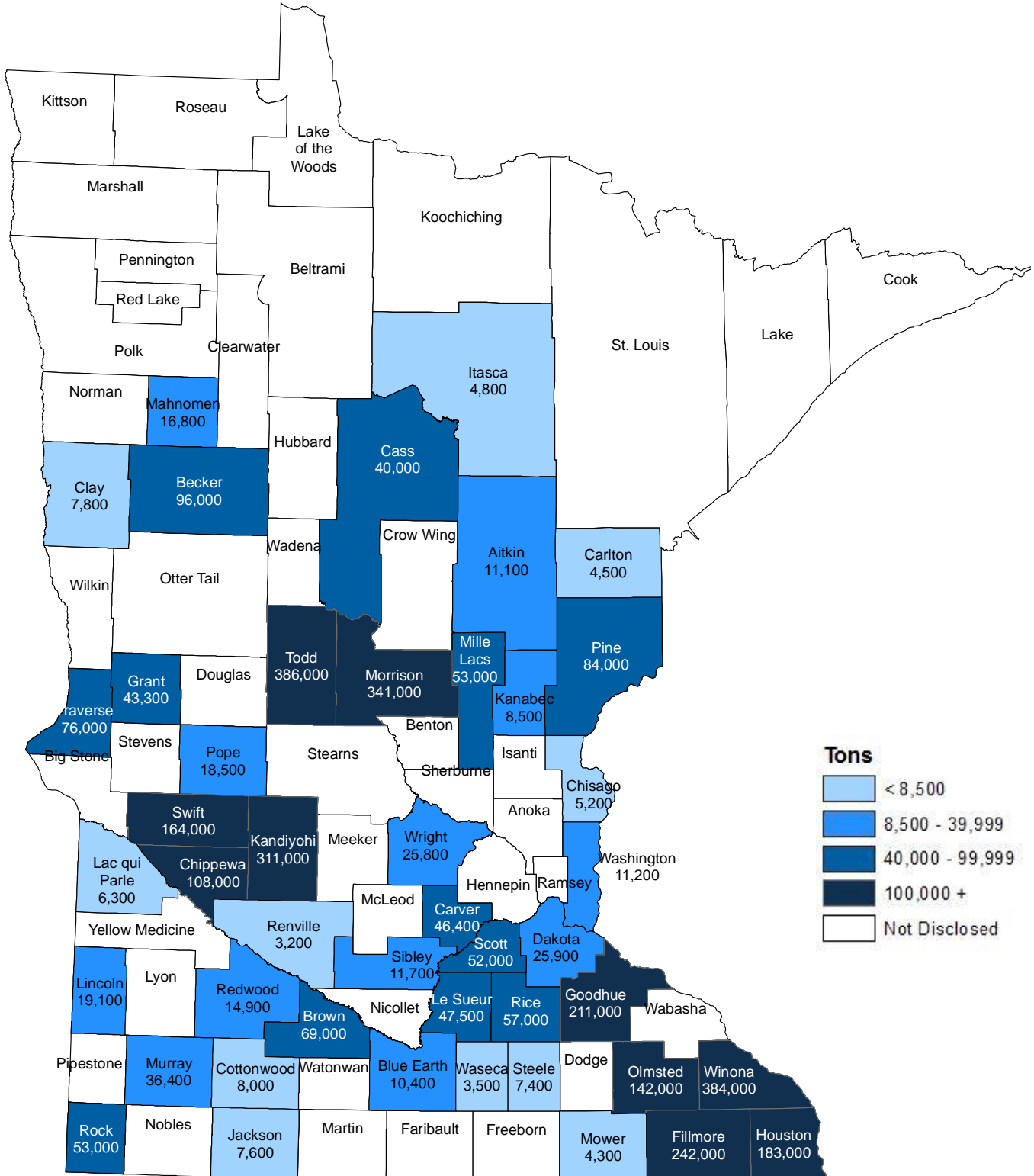

State Total: 6,475,000 Bushels



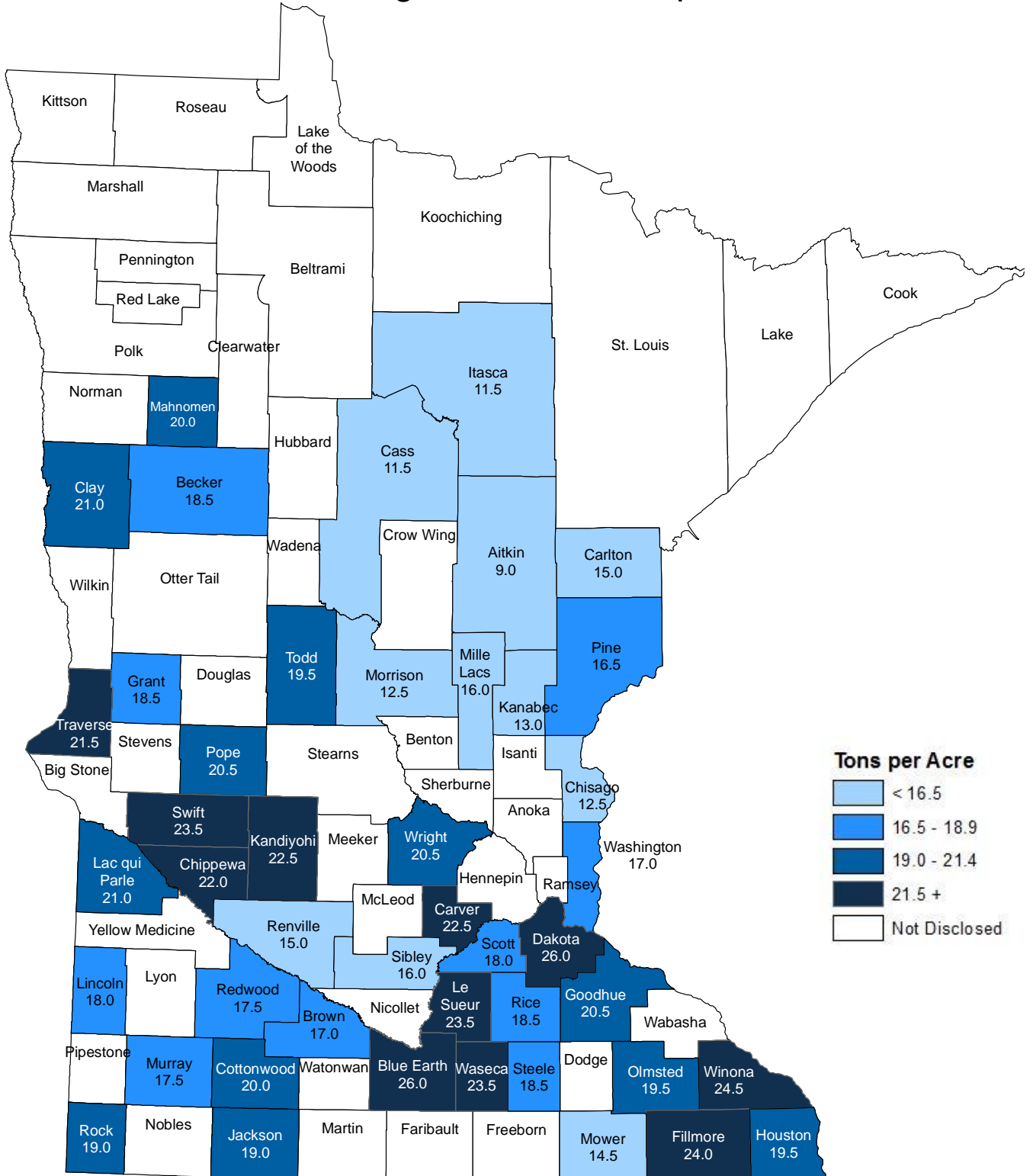
