The January 2021 average price received by farmers for **corn** in Minnesota was \$3.92 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was 19 cents above the December 2020 price and 33 cents above the January 2020 price.

The January 2021 average price received by farmers for **soybeans**, at \$11.30 per bushel, was up 90 cents from the December 2020 price and up \$2.86 from the January 2020 price.

The January 2021 price for **spring wheat** was \$5.43 per bushel, up 28 cents from December 2020 and up 54 cents from January 2020.

All hay prices in Minnesota averaged \$112.00 per ton in January, down \$3.00 from the December 2020 price and \$39.00 per ton less than January 2020. The **alfalfa hay** price was \$130.00 per ton, down \$4.00 from December 2020 and \$33.00 below a year ago. The **other hay** price was \$81.00, up \$1.00 from December 2020 but \$32.00 below a year ago.

The January average price for **milk** was \$18.30 per cwt, down 40 cents from December 2020 and down \$2.00 from one year ago.
